
This letter is to inform you that as of the date shown above the Department of Natural Resources (DNR), Wildlife Resources Division, seizes as contraband, in accordance with Official Code of Georgia Annotated (OCGA) 27-5-8, the following wild animal: 1 bull elk.

To recover the animal you may file, in the state or superior court having jurisdiction in Pickens County, a civil action against the State of Georgia, Department of Natural Resources within thirty (30) days from the date of this letter. You shall have the burden of proof showing that the animal was not held in violation of this title, and the action shall be tried as other civil cases in such court. The animal for which the action has been filed shall be held under seizure pending the resolution of the action.

This seizure shall be a constructive seizure, which means that the animal is under the authority of the Department in all aspects with the exception that you shall continue to maintain the animal at its current location. You are hereby prohibited from breeding, selling, relocating, trading, bartering, releasing, or killing the animal without the express permission of the Department.
